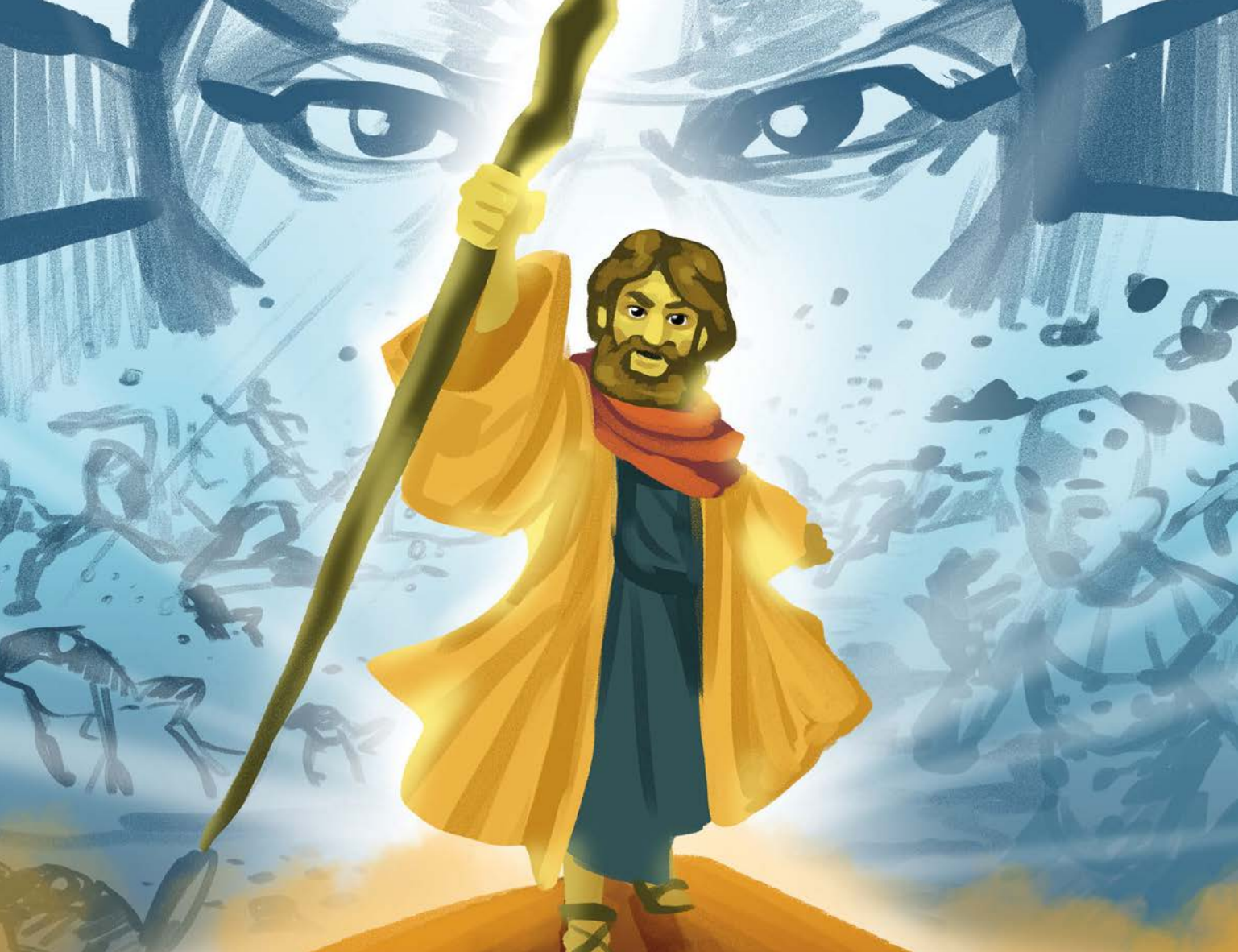
See if you can find them:
