


The Bible is a very special book,

From the earth and sun to the very first man.


God is INFINITE, but what does that mean?

God's always existed, and that is that!






Because God's all powerful, He just had to speak,

With creatures that soared while others did dive.


Now, on day 3, He made the dry land.
